

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

PROFESSIONAL PILOT BSC study programme under the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Programme

The admission process for the applicants who were nominated by their sending country for the English-language Professional Pilot BSc starts on 28 March 2022 (for the academic year 2022/2023). The admission process is ruled by Tempus Public Foundation guidelines, and the International Relations Office coordinates it with the cooperation of the relevant institutes and Tréner Ltd.

Description of the admission procedure for the Professional Pilot BSc programme:

Step 1: Online interview in English

Responsible

University of Nyíregyháza - International Relations Office, Institute of Linguistics and Literature, Institute of Engineering and Agricultural Science

Deadline

28 March 2022 to 14 April 2022: 1st choice candidates

08 April 2022 to 22 April 2022: 2nd choice candidates

Interview content

Assessment of general English language skills, personal motivation and cognitive abilities (mathematics and physics proficiency screening before the committee) - 30 minutes per person

Note:

Before the online interview, the SH coordinator and members of the selection committee will review the documents uploaded by the applicants and compare them with the requirements. The interview will include a declaration of the applicant's general health status, which is intended as a preliminary assessment of aptitude to fly.

Step 2: Self-paying online pilot aptitude test

It is compulsory to take and pass the aptitude test: without it, you are rejected by the institution on professional grounds during the admission procedure.

20 April 2022 to 07 May 2022: 2nd choice candidates

Test content

Complex online English language aptitude test to assess coordination skills, head counting, teamwork, maths and physics for a self-paying price - test duration: 3.5 hours per person

Note:

The career aptitude test is available as a service from Tréner Ltd. for a fee of 110 EUR. The service fee includes access to the TestAir360 software for the period specified by the service provider, where the candidate can practice the test tasks in 4 trial tests and take the live test once. The service is fully organised, scheduled, administered and evaluated by Tréner Ltd. Upon payment of the fee, the applicant will be granted access to the TestAir360 Pro Package software for the period specified by Tréner Ltd. The fee is non-refundable and must be paid to the account of Tréner Ltd. In case of a failed aptitude test, the applicant will not be admitted to the Professional Pilot BSc Bachelor's programme.

Step 3: Upload a Mandatory Medical Certificate to the Tempus online platform (<https://apply.stipendiumhungaricum.hu/>)

Documents are uploaded by the applicants, checked and certified by the SH coordinator of the University of Nyíregyháza

Deadline

Upload date (for the applicant): 15 April 2022- for 1st. and 2nd choice candidates

Check deadline (for the university): 16. May 2022 - required for 1st choice candidates

Note:

As required by the Tempus Public Foundation, the mandatory template requires applicants to upload a general medical certificate, which is not the same as the Class 1 medical certificate required for entry to the Pilot training.

Step 4: After receiving the scholarship and successfully completing the visa interview, you can enter Hungary

This process is entirely the responsibility of the applicant.

Step 5: Medical and psychological tests in Hungary (self-funded by the applicant)

The Institute of Engineering and Agricultural Science will assist in registering for and organizing the attendance at the 2 tests

Examinations

Aero-medical examination for Med Class 1 medical certification (according to EASA regulations) and psychological test (self-funded by the applicant).

Proposed location/ Aeromedical Centre Budapest

Expected costs:

Aero-medical examination - 33.700 HUF

Alcohol and drug test - 10.000 HUF

Psychological aptitude test - 55.000 HUF

(The price of the tests and examinations are indicative, applicants must pay the fees in force at the time of application)

Others: results of blood and urine tests not older than 1 month, chest X-ray and medical report and findings related to previous illnesses and treatments, findings related to illnesses and treatments, hospital final reports (medical documents can be submitted in English). The cost of these tests is also paid by the applicant.

Deadline

31 January 2023

Note:

Once you have been admitted as a student and started your studies, you will be required to undergo a medical and psychological aptitude test. Without obtaining a Med Class 1 medical certificate and successfully passing the psychological examination, you will not be allowed to start pilot flight training and will not be able to obtain a degree diploma. In the event of a medical disqualification, the applicant may continue his/her studies in the study programme Mechanical Engineering BSc from September of the next academic year, if his/her re-enrollment application is approved by the Tempus Public Foundation.
